



RTL Summer Courses 2007

Summer holidays are fast approaching and this provides a great opportunity to build up your child's English language foundation with RTL's Summer Courses. This year we are running four courses from the 9th July to the 23rd August.

Each course is designed to be fun, educational and encourage children to put their English into practice. The courses include:

The Activity Course (3-6 years), allows students to communicate through fun activities in small groups. Your child will be able to practise their English whilst talking about dinosaurs and other exciting study topics.

Phonics, Listening and Comprehension (P1-P6). This course has four levels to suit your child and is designed to improve listening and speaking skills in addition to building confidence. Students will expand their vocabulary and increase their general knowledge.

Reading, Language and Usage (Grammar) (P1-F5). Your child will be placed into one of five levels. This course will build up language skills and encourage correct pronunciation when reading. The course will also help develop students' ability to think and ask questions.

The Writing and Cloze Passage Course (P3-F5) has four levels and aims to improve and expand writing skills by encouraging imaginative and creative writing whilst focusing on grammar and sentence structure.
